PREFACE.

The present compilation has been undertaken with a view to removing the want of a consolidated list of the original Treaties, Engagements and Sanads in the custody of the Imperial Record Department. The documents included in this list belong to the period 1759 to 1880, with the single exception of a convention with China concluded in 1890. It is expected that the list will serve as a useful guide to all students of history. The texts and translations of most of the Treaties catalogued here have been published in Aitchison's "Treaties, Engagements and Sanads".
