Statement issued by the Supervisory Body
under Article 5.

The Supervisory Body is constituted under Article 5 of the Convention as follows:

Extract from Article 5 of the Convention:

" 7. After examination by the Supervisory Body as provided in paragraph 6 above of the estimates furnished, and after the determination by that Body as provided in Article 2 of the estimates for each country or territory on behalf of which no estimates have been furnished, the Supervisory Body shall forward, not later than November 1st in each year, through the intermediary of the Secretary-General, to all the Members of the League of Nations and non-member States referred to in Article 27, a statement containing the estimates for each country or territory, and, so far as the Supervisory Body may consider necessary, an account of any explanations given or required in accordance with paragraph 6 above, and any observations which the Supervisory Body may desire to make in respect of any such estimate or explanation, or request for an explanation."

ESTIMATED WORLD REQUIREMENTS OF DANGEROUS DRUGS IN 1936.

STATEMENT ISSUED BY THE SUPERVISORY BODY UNDER ARTICLE 5.

The Supervisory Body, constituted under paragraph 6 of Article 5 of the Limitation Convention of 1931, having examined the estimates furnished by Governments of the requirements of their respective territories in 1936, and having framed estimates for territories in respect of which estimates were not so furnished,¹ presents in the tables annexed (II and III) a statement of the estimates for each country and territory as required by paragraph 7 of that article.

Estimates were furnished in respect of (1) fifty-nine countries, including twelve countries which are *not* parties to the Convention;² (2) eighty-nine colonies, protectorates, overseas territories and territories under suzerainty or mandate.

Estimates have been framed by the Supervisory Body in respect of (1) eleven countries and (2) nine colonies, etc., in respect of which estimates were not furnished. Eight of the countries were in Central and South America.

The following table summarises in respect of each drug included in the Convention the world requirements for 1936, as shown by the estimates so furnished or made.

The grand total for each drug which appears in this table represents the *outside* limit for the world manufacture of the drug during the year. The figure is liable to modification, during the course of the year, as a result of supplementary estimates. Further, the amount of each drug which may legitimately be manufactured during the year may be less than the grand total, since, under Article 6, each manufacturing country may manufacture: (a) for its domestic consumption, for conversion and for the replenishment of its stocks, *only* the quantity of the drug which it actually requires within the limits of its estimates; and (b) for export, *only* the amount required for the execution during the year of orders received in accordance with the provisions of the Convention.

The following table compares the total of the estimates of the amounts required as such for medical and scientific use of each of the principal drugs for the three years 1934, 1935 and 1936:

The table points to an increased use of morphine and dionine, offset in part by a marked decrease in the use of diacetylmorphine. It is interesting to record that, in the case of Japan, an increase in the estimated consumption of morphine (from 950 kg. for 1934 to 1 100 kg. for 1935 and 1 281 kg. for 1936) is accompanied by a marked decrease in the estimated consumption of diacetylmorphine (from 650 kg. for 1934 to 250 kg. for 1935 and 200 kg. for 1936).

The estimated consumption of codeine, contrary to some anticipations, shows only small variations from year to year. An increase, small but steady, in the use of some of the new drugs appears to be taking place.

The marked falling-off in the cocaine estimates which was noticeable last year continues.

The most striking feature of the estimates for 1936 is the large increase in the total of the amounts of morphine estimated as required for conversion and the wide divergence between that total and the total of the estimated requirements of the drugs into which morphine is converted. The total of the estimated requirements of morphine for purposes of conversion has risen from 29 330 kg. in 1935 to 34 279 kg. in 1936 (see table in Annex I, page 78). The total of the estimates of diacetylmorphine, codeine and dionine in 1936 is 32 557 kg. (see Table I, page 3)—or nearly 2 000 kg. less than the amount of the morphine estimated as required for their production, and this notwithstanding that a substantial amount of codeine is produced, not by conversion from morphine, but by direct extraction from raw opium.

The inference would appear to be that the manufacturing countries, or some of them, are greatly over-estimating their requirements of the amounts of morphine required for conversion, and this seems to be confirmed by the statistics now available for 1934, which show that the total amount of morphine actually converted in that year was only 18 903 kg. as compared with a total estimate of 27 376, the figures for the U.S.S.R. being excluded in both cases. (See notes to page 4 of the Statement for 1935 and table in Annex I of the present statement, page 78.)

The over-estimation may be due in part to the absence of any exact information as to the world consumption of codeine (no statistics of which are required by the Convention to be furnished); and in part of the entrance since the Conference of Limitation of new countries into the field of manufacture and their hopes of capturing a part of the world trade.

Whatever the explanation, the position is one which calls for careful examination. Pending the completion by the Permanent Central Opium Board of the examination and compilation of the statistics received by it in respect of the year 1934, the Supervisory Body has not been able to

proceed further with the examination of the question and proposes to take it up again next year. Meanwhile, it is suggested to Governments of countries which are developing, or expecting to develop, an export trade in codeine and dionine that, in framing their estimate of the amount of morphine required for conversion in 1937, they should base it on the export trade done during the preceding year and increase the amount later by a supplementary estimate in the event of the export trade developing.

ENQUIRIES MADE ON ESTIMATES FURNISHED BY GOVERNMENTS.

As the purpose of the examination by the Supervisory Body of the estimates furnished by Governments is to ensure, as far as possible, against over-estimation, which would permit an excess of manufacture that would tend to find its way into the illicit traffic, the Supervisory Body is empowered to ask for information or details which it may consider necessary in order to make an estimate complete or to explain any statement made in it.

The Supervisory Body may, with the consent of the Government concerned, amend estimates in accordance with any information or details thus obtained. The Supervisory Body has no power to alter an estimate furnished in pursuance of Article 5 of the Convention without such consent, and the ultimate responsibility for the estimates furnished remains, under the Convention, with the Governments.

Apart from requests for information as to the "method" of calculation of the amounts shown in an estimate (Article 5, paragraph 3) where information on this point has been omitted, the Supervisory Body found it necessary to ask for further information or explanations in the case of twenty-three countries and nine territories.

As a result of these enquiries, certain of the Governments concerned have found it possible to make reductions in their estimates, amounting in all (to mention only the principal drugs) to 812 kg. of morphine, 20 kg. diacetylmorphine, 197 kg. codeine, 37 kg. dionine and 94 kg. cocaine.

In eleven cases, the reply to the enquiries of the Supervisory Body had not been received at the time of the preparation of the present statement.

The Supervisory Body had hoped that it would have been able this year to make a closer examination of the estimates furnished with the aid of the information supplied by the Governments on the working of the Convention during the first year of its operation, in pursuance of Article 14 of the Convention. For the reasons explained in the report of the Permanent Central Board to the Council, dated September 17th of this year,¹ the Board had not been able to complete its examination of the information supplied before the meeting of the Supervisory Body, and the full results therefore of the first year's operation of the Convention were not available for the Supervisory Body. Next year, it should be possible for the Supervisory Body to make a more effective examination.

ESTIMATES FRAMED BY SUPERVISORY BODY.

In framing estimates for countries and territories for which estimates were not furnished, the Supervisory Body has made every endeavour to safeguard the legitimate requirements of such countries and territories by taking account of all available information, including the returns which they have supplied to the Permanent Central Board or the Opium Advisory Committee of their imports, consumption and other data. Where precise data are wanting, the Supervisory Body has based its estimates on the number and character of population, development of medical practice and other relevant considerations.

Under Article 3 of the Convention, it is open to any country for which an estimate has been framed by the Supervisory Body to furnish a supplementary estimate in the event of the amounts fixed by the Supervisory Body proving to be inadequate for, or possibly in excess of, the needs of the country; but, pending such a supplementary estimate, exports from countries which are parties to the Convention will be limited to the amounts fixed by the Supervisory Body.

OBSERVATIONS IN REGARD TO THE MODE OF PREPARATION OF ESTIMATES.

1. The Supervisory Body would again emphasise the fact that the Statement which it issues of the estimates forms the basis for the application during the year to which it refers of the system of control, national and international, established by the Convention, and indicates the limits within which the Governments parties to the Convention have undertaken to confine their manufacture, and their export and import, of the drugs during the year. While it is of the first importance that any over-estimation should be avoided if the objects of the Convention are to be obtained, it is also necessary for the smooth working of the Convention that the estimates should provide for *all* the drugs which are likely to be needed during the year. *The Supervisory Body has*

been informed by the Permanent Central Board that there have already been a number of cases (21) during the current year in which Governments have imported drugs—usually in small quantities—for which no provision was made in their estimates for 1935. In such cases, the procedure indicated in Article 14 of the Convention comes into operation, and inconvenience may be caused to the Governments concerned which would have been avoided if complete estimates had been furnished in the first instance.

2. The examination of the estimates for 1936 shows that there still exist in many quarters *misunderstandings* as to the nature of the estimates required by the Convention. It has again happened that a number of countries have given, in their estimates for 1936, the quantities which they expect to import, not the quantities which they expect to consume. It is necessary, therefore, to emphasise that the estimates under the Limitation Convention must show the full amounts which will be required for internal consumption in the country during the year, whether these amounts are to be imported or taken from stocks already in the country or are to be manufactured.

The provisions of the Convention as to “stocks” have also been misunderstood in a number of cases. A case which is perhaps typical of not a few small territories is the following: A certain territory in the spring of each year imports all the supplies it will require during the ensuing twelve months. At the end of the year, it has approximately a quarter's supply in hand. At the end of that quarter, it will import all that it will require during the next twelve months. The Government of the territory, being in doubt as to what is required by the Convention, inserted, as the amounts required to bring its stock up to the desired level, quantities equal to the supplies needed during the remaining three quarters of the year, and asked whether this was correct. In view of the purpose of the “stock” provisions, the answer is that such a territory has *no* “reserve stocks” and no amount should be inserted under headings III, IV and V of the Form of Return. Other Governments have supposed that the amount required to be inserted in heading IV (amount required to bring stocks up to the desired level) should include the amount required to be imported for normal consumption during the year in addition to the amounts required to make good any depletion of the reserves or, alternatively, that the amount to be inserted in heading I (normal consumption) should include also the amount required to make good any depletion of the reserves.

3. *Basis of Estimates of Consumption.* — As was the case last year, the estimates submitted by Governments appear in a number of instances to be considerably higher than the consumption statistics for previous years (as reported to the Permanent Central Board) would seem to warrant.

As the Model Administrative Code for the application of the Convention, drawn up by the Opium Advisory Committee, points out (document C.774.M.365.1932.XI):

“Estimates of future consumption must necessarily be based on statistics of past consumption if they are to be real estimates and not merely guesses . . . It may be suggested that, generally speaking, the estimates should be based primarily on the consumption figures for the last available year, but that the consumption figures of several years should be considered, so as to see whether there is a tendency for the consumption of any particular drug to increase or decrease.”

It should be added that the *value* of the consumption statistics to the Supervisory Body in its examination of estimates depends on the manner in which those statistics are compiled. The Supervisory Body has observed wide fluctuations from year to year in the consumption statistics of certain countries, fluctuations not perhaps explainable by changes of circumstances, and the Supervisory Body is glad to have been informed that the general question of the compilation of consumption statistics is under consideration by the Opium Advisory Committee and the Permanent Central Board.

In two or three cases, this tendency to over-estimate may have been due to the adoption of a practice of basing estimates on returns made by traders and wholesalers of their prospective requirements. Estimates furnished by wholesalers or dealers of the amounts they may require for the purpose of their individual business in the course of a year are a factor which may properly be taken into account; but they would not seem *by themselves* to furnish a safe basis for the calculation of a country's requirements, as they are liable to be framed to cover the full extent of the business each firm hopes to do.

4. *Allowance of Margins for Possible Fluctuations in Demand.* — The Convention (paragraph 3 of Article 5) provides that, in the calculation of their estimated requirements, Governments may include a margin to allow for possible fluctuations in demand. In some of the estimates furnished this year, as was the case last year, the margin included appeared to the Supervisory Body unnecessarily high. In one or two instances, the Government has estimated the normal consumption by taking the average consumption during the three or four preceding years, and adding to that figure, by way of margin, the difference between it and the highest consumption figure during any one of those years. In several cases, the Supervisory Body has been able, as a result of correspondence with the Government concerned, to secure a reduction of the margin

with a consequent reduction in the consumption estimate. It would again call attention to the recommendation in the Model Administrative Code that:

“ In cases where the provision of a margin may be considered necessary, such margin should be kept at the lowest possible figure, since, otherwise, the purpose of the Convention to limit manufacture to the actual medical and scientific needs may be defeated.”

In this connection, the Supervisory Body would again emphasise that the Convention allows of three methods for meeting possible fluctuations in demand. One is the allowance of a margin on the consumption and conversion estimates. Another is the faculty of submitting at any time a supplementary estimate in the event of the original estimate proving to be inadequate. A third is the possibility of *drawing upon the stocks normally maintained* in the hands of manufacturers and wholesalers. The depletion of the stocks thus caused may be made good either by a supplementary estimate sent in during the course of the year or by inserting in the estimates for the following year (heading IV) the amount necessary to bring the stocks up to the desired level.

STATEMENT OF METHOD USED IN FRAMING ESTIMATES.

In its Statements for 1934 and 1935, the Supervisory Body pointed out that a number of Governments had omitted to send with their estimates a “ statement explaining the method by which the several amounts shown in it have been calculated ”, and that such statements are essential to the successful carrying-out of its duties.

The statement of method is again lacking entirely in a number of the estimates for 1936, and in others the statement fails to show clearly how the several amounts included in the estimates have been calculated.

The Supervisory Body has accordingly, in such cases, addressed to the Governments concerned a letter, from which the following extracts may be quoted:

“

“ In the absence of such a statement, the Supervisory Body experience difficulty in making the explanation of the estimates which they are required to make by paragraph 6 of Article 5, and as result, in a number of cases they are compelled to refer back to the Governments for further information and explanations. It would save the Governments trouble as well as facilitate the work of the Supervisory Body if the Governments, when sending their estimates, would explain clearly how the estimated amounts in the case of *each* drug have been arrived at. This applies to the figures under each of the headings I, II, III and IV of the statistical form B (L). *Where the statement of method has already been fully given in connection with estimates for previous years and there is nothing fresh to be added, it would be sufficient if a reference were given to the previous statement, mentioning the year.*”

(For countries which import all their requirements):

“ As all the drugs required are imported, the estimates will presumably be based on a calculation of the consumption during (one or more) preceding years, with due allowance for any probable developments in the medical service or otherwise and, as regards reserve stocks, on the amounts which it is found necessary, in view of the distance from the sources of supply or otherwise, to keep in hand so that the needs of the country may be adequately met. It would help the Supervisory Body in its work if the manner in which the calculation of consumption, and of stocks, were also explained.”

(For countries which manufacture and/or export):

“ If the consumption estimates are based on the figures of actual consumption in (one or more) preceding years, it would help the Supervisory Body in its work if an explanation were given of the manner in which the figures of actual consumption for the preceding years were arrived at.”

“ It is also particularly important, as your country is a country which manufactures (and exports) the drugs, that the method of determining (a) the stock level which it is desired to maintain (heading III), (b) the quantities required to bring the actual stocks up to the desired level (heading IV), be exactly explained.”

The Supervisory Body would emphasise one point to which reference was made in last year’s Statement.

Considerable diversity of method appears to exist as regards the calculation of the amounts, if any, to be inserted in headings IV and V of the Form B (L). So far as reserve stocks are concerned, the amount can only be determined with exactness when the stocks in hand at the end of the preceding year have been ascertained from the returns of the manufacturers and wholesalers; and some Governments adopt the practice of leaving these headings (IV and V) blank in the estimates and sending in a supplementary estimate after the end of the year, when the stocks then in hand have been ascertained. Many of the estimates furnished, on the other hand, include in heading IV an amount calculated on the basis either of the stock ascertained to be in hand at a particular date or dates in the preceding year, or on other data.

The matter is one of considerable importance, especially in the case of countries having a considerable export trade, and the Supervisory Body would ask Governments which adopt the method of estimating *in advance* the amounts which may be required during the ensuing year to bring the stocks in hand at the end of the year up to the desired level, to explain precisely, when sending in their estimates, the manner in which the amounts have been calculated. It may be noted here that the total of the estimated amounts required to bring up stocks to the desired level shows a great decrease on the totals of the two previous years in the case of most of the drugs.

Similar considerations apply to the calculation of the amount required for maintenance of Government stocks (heading V).

The Supervisory Body is glad to record that many of the statements supplied by Governments show that great care has been taken in the preparation of the estimates.

A minor difficulty has arisen in the case of some of the smaller Possessions which import the small quantities of the drugs they require in the form, mostly, of various preparations. It happens occasionally that a more than adequate supply of some preparations is in hand, while there is a shortage of others, with the result that, as the morphine content (for example) of all the morphine preparations has to be given in a lump figure, the stock in hand more than balances the estimated consumption, making the total of the estimates a "minus" figure. As this would prevent the importation of certain necessary preparations of which there is a shortage, the Supervisory Body has arranged with the Governments of the Possessions in question to revise their figures so as to allow of such importation. The amounts inscribed being very small, the working of the Convention will not in any degree be prejudiced.

DIFFICULTIES OF THE SUPERVISORY BODY.

In its Statement for the year 1935, the Supervisory Body called attention to the difficulties which it experienced in completing its examination of the estimates by the date fixed in the Convention.

The procedure of the Supervisory Body is to hold two sessions: the first in August, at which it decides what requests to make for further information or for explanations from Governments; the second in October, at which it considers the replies received and prepares the Statement of the Estimates.

So far as regards the difficulty caused by delay in sending in the estimates (due by August 1st), the position this year has again improved. By the close of its August session, only eighteen countries and twenty-three colonies and other territories had failed to send in their estimates. Estimates from seven countries and fourteen colonies and territories were received after the close of the August session. The delay in the case of some distant countries was due to the Estimates Form not being received in sufficient time, and arrangements will be made for its earlier despatch in future.

In spite of this improvement, the Supervisory Body has not been able to complete its examination. It will be seen from the notes to the tables that certain estimates are still the subject of correspondence with the Governments concerned. In some cases, no reply to the enquiries of the Supervisory Body has yet been received, and in other cases the replies have not been such as to enable the Supervisory Body to come to a definite conclusion. This difficulty is very largely due to the shortness of the interval allowed by the Convention for the work of the Supervisory Body (August-October). The preparation of the material by the Secretariat for the Supervisory Body's consideration and the first session of the Supervisory Body occupy the greater part of August. The second session of the Supervisory Body must take place early in October, if the Statement is to be prepared and printed in time for circulation to the Governments by November 1st. At the most, the time available for correspondence between the Supervisory Body and Governments is six weeks. This interval is not long enough for the Supervisory Body's enquiry to reach a distant country, for the consideration of the points it raises by the authorities concerned, and for their reply to reach Geneva. It is a matter for consideration whether, by some modification of the dates fixed in the Convention, more time could be allowed for the work of the Supervisory Body.

The Supervisory Body's work has been rendered specially difficult in the case of some countries (more particularly countries in Central and South America) by the fact that the Governments of those countries have failed to supply the Permanent Central Board with the statistical information required by the Conventions.

SUPPLEMENTARY ESTIMATES.

1. Since the issue in November 1934 of its Statement containing the estimates for 1935, the Supervisory Body has received, and dealt with, in accordance with the provisions of Article 5 of the Convention, sixty-two supplementary estimates relating to the current year. This was a much smaller number than the number received in 1934, and indicated that the Governments were perfecting their machinery for estimating the requirements.

The Supervisory Body has made arrangements to examine such estimates without delay, as required by paragraph 8 of Article 5; but, as was the case last year, a number of these estimates were not accompanied by an explanation of the circumstances which necessitated them, as required by Article 3 of the Convention. The Supervisory Body would point out again that, without such explanation, it is in most cases impossible for it to deal immediately with the estimate. Information has to be asked for and some delay results. As supplementary estimates may be, and in a number of cases have been, required to meet emergencies of an urgent nature, it is important, if delay is to be avoided, that a full explanation of the circumstances should be sent with the estimate.

2. The Supervisory Body also received, *after* the end of 1934, thirty-two supplementary estimates relating to that year. Some of these were despatched shortly before the close of the year, the majority not until after its close. Under Article 3 of the Convention, a Supplementary Estimate must be furnished *in* the year to which it relates and, as the Supervisory Body can take no effective action on estimates received after the close of the year to which they relate and the circulation of them to the Governments would serve no practical purpose, the Supervisory Body has decided not to circulate them, but to communicate them, with such observations as may be required, to the Permanent Central Board for its information in connection with the examination by it of the statistics subsequently received in regard to the year in question.

"The total of the estimates" (Article 5, paragraph 2) consists of the sum of the following amounts:

- (1) The quantity of the drug estimated as necessary for use *as such*;
- (2) The quantity of the drug estimated as necessary for the purpose of conversion into other drugs (*e.g.*, morphine into diacetylmorphine, codeine, dionine);
- (3) The amounts of the drug necessary to bring the "reserve stocks" and the "Government stocks" up to the desired level or the amounts to be deducted to bring them down to such level.

These amounts are given in detail in Table III.

All drugs are given in terms of the basic anhydrous alkaloid.

The names of countries and territories for which estimates have been made by the Supervisory Body are printed in *italics*.

This table defines:

(a) For non-manufacturing countries, the maximum amount of each drug that may be imported during the course of the year, account being taken of any quantities exported (see Article 12, paragraph (2)).

(b) For manufacturing countries, the maximum amount that may be manufactured by each country in addition to the amount required for execution of export orders received during the year.

The vertical columns in the table marked I, II, III, IV and V respectively correspond to the following sections of the statistical form B (L):

- III = The amount of the reserve stocks which it is desired to maintain.
